Psi Chi Mentors are expected to model and help instill helpful academic behavior, to this end mentors will be expected to help their mentee plan short term and long term goals and be expected to have a personal friendship with their mentee.

To qualify to be a Psi Chi Mentor you must be:

- *At least an upper division or 3rd year Psychology Major*
- *Involved in Psi Chi regardless of current Psi Chi Membership status*

*While **there is no GPA requirement**, GPA is one indicator of academic achievement and may be used to choose between two qualified applicants.*

Mentors will be expected to:

- *Meet quarterly to discuss and set long term and short term goals. **Mentors may not set goals for mentees**, mentees must choose their own goals. The mentor may facilitate the generation of ideas and help plan steps to achieving those goals.*
- *Meet weekly with their mentee in a social type setting. The duration and type of meeting is at the discretion of you and your mentee. Examples include: Meeting for lunch, having a study session, hanging out on campus, meeting in building 5 before classes, attending Psi Chi events together.*
